YOUR CHANCE TO PEEP INSIDE A WORKING STUDIO

Summer Art Weeks enables you to enjoy wonderful art in interesting places, but the best way to 'experience' it is by visiting a working studio.

As the name suggests, this was the original premise behind Warwickshire Open Studios. For a short period each year, artists and makers would open their studios and invite art lovers into their world.

Since 2000, our Summer Art Weeks has evolved to include group events and pop-up exhibitions in private homes and gardens as well as various public spaces, whilst remaining true to the essence of Open Studios. This year we're delighted to have a significant number of venues that are working studios and we hope that you'll manage to visit some of them.

Where the magic happens...

Whether it's in a converted garage, a purpose-built garden studio or a commercial space, a working studio gives you a peep into the artistic process and specialist equipment involved. Most of our artists will be working on new pieces during Summer Art Weeks. Seeing this in action gives you a deeper appreciation of the time, skill and patience required to produce the end product – from raw materials to finished artwork.

Visiting working studios also provides a fascinating insight into artists' creative spaces, from paint-splattered floors to wood shavings everywhere. What's more, artists love to chat about their work and their inspirations; it's even better if they can show not just tell!









Working studio

To identify the working studios taking part this summer, look for the label next to the individual entries, or go to the working studios index at the back of the brochure.

NOTE: Because of the tools and equipment in situ as well as artworks in progress, working studios are generally not suitable environments for young children or dogs. Please bear this in mind when planning your visits, or check with the individual artist(s) first.





OUR 2024 BURSARY WINNERS

We are delighted to once again support a diverse range of emerging artists with our Emerge bursary scheme for 2024. We welcomed applications from talented artists aged 18 and above, working in any art medium, who have never participated in WOS Summer Art Weeks before. Our bursary is designed to facilitate emerging artists to get involved in Summer Art Weeks, and assist in their transition to becoming an established artist.

Our winners have been awarded £250 cash as well as one year's free WOS registration and their Summer Art Weeks' entry paid, plus support in finding a venue. In addition, they receive mentoring support from an established artist to help them prepare for the event.













The winners:

Paula Wilkinson (jeweller at venue 51 & 87)
Paula creates her pieces from 100% recycled solid sterling silver and semi-precious gemstones.
She draws her inspiration from nature and the beauty in the materials themselves. She says: "A little of my soul goes into each and every piece and although the process can be challenging, it is immensely satisfying when an imagined design becomes a completed piece of jewellery."

Tom Godwin (photographer at venue 99)
Tom uses analogue and digital experimental photography to distort landscapes and structures into surreal, dynamic images. Tom says: "The use of colour is a very important aspect of my practice as I am interested in the way different colours can evoke emotions and the way people attach personal memories to them."

Verónica Valdés (ceramicist at venue 59)

After a long break, Veronica has recently restarted her ceramics practice inspired by nature, plants, geological strata and stones. Veronica has recently embarked on a joint project with one of last year's bursary winners, Clare Shilvock. Veronica says: "I enjoy using oxides and slips and experimenting with texture."
